Sealed Bids for the construction of the SWITCHGEAR AND TRANSFORMER REPLACEMENT PROJECT P80115 are invited and will be received by the Metropolitan Wastewater Management Commission ("MWMC") at the office of the City of Springfield Administrative Services, located at Springfield City Hall, 225 Fifth Street, Springfield, Oregon 97477, **on or before 2 P.M. local time, on Tuesday August 13, 2024**. All sealed Bids will be time-stamped upon arrival at the front desk of the Administrative Services, Springfield City Hall. Each Bidder shall submit its Bid on the MWMC Bid form and shall either provide a disclosure of any first-tier subcontractors at time of bid or within two (2) working hours after Bid closing. The Bids will be opened at 4:00 P.M. local time on Tuesday August 13, 2024, Bid prices announced, and receipt of first-tier subcontractors disclosure form identified.

Sealed envelopes or packages containing Bids must be marked on the outside with Bidder's Name and the statement, "Bid for MWMC SWITCHGEAR AND TRANSFORMER REPLACEMENT PROJECT P80115." Any Bids sent by mail must include the Bidder's name and be forwarded certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to MWMC, in care of Nathan Bell, Finance Director, Department of Finance, 225 Fifth Street, Springfield, Oregon 97477, and likewise must be clearly marked "Bid for MWMC SWITCHGEAR AND TRANSFORMER REPLACEMENT PROJECT P80115" Mailed bids must be received in the office of the City of Springfield Administrative Services by the due date and time.

Bids are invited for the following scope of Work for this Project:

- Replacement of Primary Power Switching Station (PPSS) medium voltage switchgear at the MWMC Water Pollution Control Facility (WPCF).
- Replacement of Willakenzie Primary Power Switching Station (WPPSS) medium voltage switchgear at the Willakenzie Pump Station, including procurement and installation of switchgear.
- Replacement of seven (7) medium voltage transformers at the MWMC Water Pollution Control Facility (WPCF), including procurement and installation of transformers.
- Replacement of two (2) medium voltage transformers at the Willakenzie Pump Station, including procurement and installation of transformers.
- Temporary power to meet construction constraint provisions identified.
- Demolition of the equipment.
- Related civil, architectural, mechanical, plumbing, structural, electrical, I&C and communications work.
- Contract and coordination Yokogawa for temporary and permanent modifications to the plant distributed control system (DCS).

This project is a public works project subject to Prevailing Wage Rates as contemplated under ORS 279C.800 to ORS 279C.870. Subject to applicable exemptions, every Bidder and every subcontractor of Bidder is required to have a public works bond filed with BOLI prior to the commencement of Work on this Project.

A <u>mandatory</u> pre-bid conference for General Contractors will be held at the Regional Water Pollution Control Facility (WPCF) located at 410 River Avenue, Eugene, Oregon on July 31, 2024 at 9:30 am.
